Conditions of Entry:

- Entry is free and open to all children in full time education, including home school.
- Exhibitors must have raised, cared for and feed the animals themselves.
- Age of child to be taken as at 1 October of the current show season.
SENIOR 11 years and under 14 years
INTERMEDIATE 8 years and under 11 years
JUNIOR 5 years and under 8 years
- All entries must be penned by 9.30am.
- Only one animal may be entered by each competitor.
- Competitors shall lead their own calves, kids or lambs before the judges, unless judges grant permission otherwise.
- The leading course will be explained to entrants by the stewards prior to the competition.
- The Steward has the right to combine any classes.

Calves **must not** be clipped or oiled.

Adults may assist to wash calves which arrive dirty, but any subsequent grooming or handling must be done by children only

TB & NAIT POLICY: See Rules & Regulations at the front of the Cattle Sheep and Goats section. All calves must have in their ears the official primary and secondary AHB tags.

Dairy calves (heifers only) must be born between 1 June 2014 and 31 August 2014.

Beef calves (includes heifers and all bull and steer calves) must be born between 1 June 2014 and 30 September 2014.

Dairy Calf Definitions:

Light Breed: Jersey, Ayrshire

Heavy Breeds: Holstein -Friesian, Dairy Shorthorn

Beef Calf Definitions:

Traditional: Dairy Bulls or Steers, Hereford, Angus, Murray Grey, Beef Shorthorn – Pure or crosses

Exotic: Limousin, Simmental, Belgian Blue, Charolais etc pure or crosses

Calves will be judged on Leading and Rearing, plus Dairy or Beef type.

JUDGING FOLLOWING ON FROM CALF CLUB

Competitors entered in the Calf Club Section are not eligible to enter this section.

Competitors must have been involved in the rearing and handling of the animal.

Open to competitors 12 to 18 years at 1 October of the current Show season.

Calves must be born between 1 June and 30 September inclusive.

Competitors may only enter the following: 1 calf or 1 yearling or 1 calf + 1 yearling

Competition is open to heifer, steer or bull calves.

No bull or steer calves in the Dairy Section.

Clipping is optional.

The leading course will be explained to entrants by the Stewards prior to the competition.

TB POLICY: See Rules and Regulations. All calves must have in their ears the official primary and secondary AHB tags. A copy of the TB test certificate must accompany the entry form for yearlings.
