All care will be taken with your birds but the Clevedon A & P Association will not accept responsibility for any accident or mishap whatsoever. Sick or parasite infested birds will not be judged and will be removed from the Show.

PENNING OF BIRDS Birds must be penned no later than 9.30am. Judging will commence at 10am.

DEPENNING OF BIRDS Exhibitors may remove birds after 4pm on Saturday 18th November

Entries close 31st October 2017
