Classes are open to all purebred registered PRE, Spanish (non-ANCCE registered), Lipizzaner, Lusitano, Peruvian Paso, Paso Fino and Friesian Horses. You must record your breed and association registration on the entry form.

**NOTE:** Purebred and partbred horses must enter only one section – i.e. If purebred you may only enter Purebred Foundation Breeds (if eligible) OR Purebred Other Iberian classes, if partbred you may only enter Partbred Foundation Breeds or Partbred Other Iberian classes

All competitors entered are to assist with the putting up and taking down of the equipment used for the Working Equitation and Jumping classes to help with the smooth running of the show.

Iberian horses do not require a height certificate, *unless*, they are competing in other sections of the show.

## **Costume & Equitation Classes**

- Class 492** AUTHENTIC TACK & COSTUME CLASS

Judged on the correctness of the appearance of the horse and rider in their breed's authentic tack and riding costume. Tack and costume to be Spanish, Portuguese or other authentic tack and costume pertaining to breed shown. I.e. Spanish Traje Corto (Vaquera or Clasica), Portuguese Classical (Amazona or Cavaleiro) etc.

- Class 493** WORKING EQUITATION CLASS - OBSTACLE COURSE

Open to horses entered in the Spanish & Iberian sections in the show only. Horses to be judged on their willingness to approach equipment and perform set tasks. To be done in authentic tack and costume (or standard tack and costume).

Marks will be deducted for the use of both hands on reins during the completion of the obstacles or tasks but reins may be used in both hands between tasks if necessary in order to pick up items of equipment etc. Marks will be deducted for failure to complete the obstacle or task. Marks will be deducted for the use of non-traditional tack or costume. While it is preferred that many of the obstacles are done at the canter it may be necessary to do some at other pace such as walk, trot or rein-back.

Typical tasks and obstacles may include: Open and shut a gate, go through a simple maze & ring a bell and rein-back out of maze, attack a 'cow' with a garrocha, carry a flapping flag on a long pole around the arena, trot or canter around an obstacle or cloverleaf showing change of lead through trot or walk (or flying change), collect rings on a spear, sword or garrocha, spear a target, drag an item around a set course, side pass or half pass along a pole, drag an item along the ground.

**15 minute break to allow tack changes**

## **Ridden Flat Classes**

Ridden classes are open to all purebred & partbred ridden horses. Horses and riders may enter only one category – Maiden, Novice or Open as detailed below.

A maiden horse/rider – Has not competed at novice or open level before.

A novice horse/rider – Has 0 to 5 wins or places in A&P (Novice ring) or other such ridden competitions. An open horse/rider – Has 6 or more wins or places in competition.
